Description: A foot warmer stool; consists of the stool (a) which is a rectangular wooden box with four rubber feet; it has a lid made out of what appears to be a "Berlin Work Wool" cover; inside the box is the foot warmer tin (b) which is an aluminum box with a capped spout on one end for pouring water in; the cap is stuck in place.
